# **Guidelines for Online Application Submissions**

- 1. Online Portal is accessed on the Ministry of Natural Resources, Petroleum, and Mining Website-Home Page- Physical Planning Submission (Ministry of Natural Resources – The way we live, the way we create, the way we sustain...)
- 2. Properly complete the Submission Form. To be completed by applicant submitting the application.
- 3. Select type of application you are submitting.
- 4. Download Application Form. **ALL** application forms are FILLABLE. Must be typewritten. NO HANDWRITTEN forms will be accepted.
- 5. Completed application form is to be printed, **SIGNED** and **DATED** before uploading.
- 6. **ALL** relevant documents are to be uploaded in the proper format (jpeg, PDF, AutoCAD for plans).

## **Online Application Submission Process**

- 1. Submission is received by the Physical Planning Section via the online platform.
- 2. Application is vetted to ensure that forms are completed correctly and all relevant documents are submitted.
- 3. If submission is complete, an email with the **Instrument Receipt** will be sent to the applicant.
- 4. Complete applications will be processed. Applicant will be notified when application is approved and letter is available for pick up.
- 5. If application is incomplete, applicant will be notified via an email from the official online submissions email (<a href="mailto:ppsubmissions@naturalresources.gov.bz">ppsubmissions@naturalresources.gov.bz</a>) of the pending documents.
- 6. ALL pending documents are to be submitted through the online portal on the Ministry's website. **Re-submission** option is to be selected.
- 7. Once applicant submits pending documents and meets all the requirements, then will the applicant receive an instrument number via email.
- 8. **NO** submission will be accepted via email. **ALL** submissions must be made through the online portal.
